Students interested in exploring a career in a skilled trade such as carpentry, iron working, or highway/bridge construction will not want to miss this program!

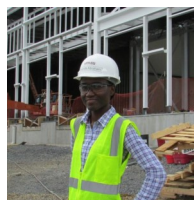
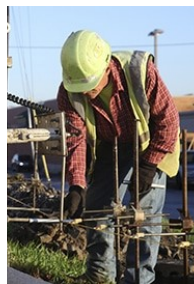
